Integrated Rural Health & Development Programme

Tribhuvandas Foundation is an Integrated Rural Health & Development Programme of Amul. Inspired by the great success of round the clock health care services to the livestock of dairy farmers of Kaira, Shri Tribhuvandas Patel, the Founder Chairman of Amul, felt the need for such a service to the rural populace too, as he could learn and experience the afflictions brought to them by absence of medical services in the villages of erstwhile Kaira district, particularly women & children. He donated the prize money of his Ramon Magsaysay Award and the fund he received from Kaira farmers on his retirement, for his life time services to them, to set up this Foundation. Dr V. Kurien played an active role in the initiation of this programme. It was registered as a Charitable Trust under the Public Trust Act 1950, in July 1975.

TF is an organization that is owned by the people, run by the people, working for the people and supported by the people. Tribhuvandas Foundation is mainly funded by farmers, who are also the users of the programs.

The Foundation also derives its uniqueness from the fact that it is a need-based programme for villagers. It fulfills the basic health care needs of the villages. Apart from providing primary treatment for various common ailments, the Foundation is also actively involved in spreading awareness about preventive health practices and health promotion. Its main thrust is on improving the health of women and children. It is headquartered at Anand with sub-centers spread over the districts Anand and Kheda. The Foundation has a dedicated Team of Medical Officers, Nurses and Field workers, Administrative staff and Village Health Workers to provide the following services:

Range of services

Tribhuvandas Foundation has become one of Asia's largest community healthcare service providers covering 835 villages.



Primary Healthcare Program

The Primary Healthcare program is a very important program of TF. It operates in all of the program villages of TF- approximately 850 villages. Each year, TF provides primary health care services through its Village Health Workers to about 800,000 individuals.



The Menstrual Hygiene Programme Women for change

The foundation is running this programme on its own and is providing sanitary pads at an affordable cost.



The mother and child healthcare program



The mother and child health care program is a major and important program of Tribhuvandas Foundation. In fact, Tribhuvandas Foundation was founded in order to provide home-based mother and child health care to villagers. Due to this the quality of home based care of mothers and children is improving progressively.

Prevention of tobacco addiction Programme

Tribhuvandas Foundation has learned from the experience that prevention of tobacco addiction is much more important than de-addiction of the addicted individuals. Tribhuvandas Foundation workers go to various schools in the programme villages and carry out awareness programmes with this objective. The response in this initiative is very encouraging.



Clinical/ Hospital facility for rural people

Every year, Tribhuvandas Foundation treats more than 300,000 patients in various clinics and conducts more than 1800 deliveries in the maternity hospital at Kapadvanj/ Anand centers.
